An exciting and challenging opportunity is available for a **General Farm Worker** to join our team. The successful incumbent will be based at the N/a'an ku sê TimBila Nature Reserve, 230km from Windhoek.

The General Farm Worker will be responsible for all small-scale farm work, including fencing, fixing pipelines, feeding game, cleaning, debussing/cutting firewood, and any other required tasks. Must be willing to work long hours and be available for any farm work at any given time. Needs to be able to work as a team.

Main responsibilities (but not limited to):

- Perform general farm tasks such as planting, cultivating, and harvesting crops.
- Assist with the care and feeding of livestock, including feeding, watering, and cleaning animal housing.
- Operate and maintain farm equipment and machinery.
- Perform fencing tasks, including installation, repair, and maintenance of fences.
- Maintain and repair irrigation systems, pipelines, and other farm infrastructure.
- Assist with pest and weed control as needed.
- Perform general maintenance tasks around the farm, including cleaning, painting, and repairing buildings and equipment.
- Help with the loading and unloading of supplies and products.
