An exciting and challenging opportunity is available for a **Research Volunteer Coordinator** to join our team. The successful incumbent will be based at the N/a'an Ku Se TimBila Nature Reserve, 230km from Windhoek.

Main responsibilities (but not limited to):

- Assist in the successful implementation of the volunteer programme.
- Coordinate groups of volunteers from different nationalities, age groups, and skill sets.
- Regularly carry out game population assessments on the reserve using various methods, such as game counts and camera traps.
- Conduct research on the reserve to support management decisions or gather data in line with the company's research goals.
- Support conservation efforts for all wildlife within the reserve.
- Assist with handling human-wildlife conflict cases in the surrounding areas.
- Help with the preparation and presentation of research or educational talks.
- Write reports or scientific papers based on research conducted at TimBila.
- Perform general upkeep and maintenance of accommodation and vehicles.
- Carry out any other tasks that may be reasonably expected.

Job requirements and skills:

- A Degree/Diploma in any science related field.
- A Field Guide Association of Southern Africa (FGASA) qualification at any level would be an advantage.
